

Fire-ban Campfire



Materials:

- White tissue paper
- Red and yellow food colouring & bowl to put it in
- Sticks
- Pipecleaners
- Scissors
- Scotch Tape

Optional:

- Marshmallows
- rocks

Step One:

Put 7 drops of each colour of food colouring into two separate bowls. Dilute with 1 tbsp of water. Dip the tissue paper into the mixture gently or paint it on with a paint or pastry brush. Lay the paper out flat or hang over a clothesline to dry.

Step Two:

Once dry, cut the tissue paper into water droplet shapes of various sizes.

Tape your dyed tissue paper to the pipecleaners.

Bend the pipecleaners to make the tissue paper look like dancing flames

Step Three: Wrap the bottoms of the pipelines around sticks. Pile the sticks so that they are supporting each other and the "flames" overlap

Step Four: Lay rocks around your "Fire" in a circle. Sing campfire songs and enjoy some marshmallows with the people in your household!
